1. Free expert energy efficiency advice

If your college is an SME we can offer a free energy audit worth £630. These surveys result in practical, evidence -based guidance on energy efficiency and highlight tailored recommendations that can lead to significant financial and carbon emissions savings.

We've helped over 100 businesses, schools and community organisations in Oxfordshire and, because the advice is tailored, recipients report high conversion from recommendation to action: A recent survey indicated 75% of recommended actions were either complete or planned.

2. Purchase zero carbon, community generated electricity

Each year, Oxfordshire spends £1.5 billion on energy – purchase your electricity direct from the Low Carbon Hub and ensure your energy spend stays local, delivering economic, social and environmental benefits. What's more, our Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) offer clear chain of custody for locally generated, zero carbon electricity. We can match or better your current energy costs and give long term cost certainty linked to RPI rather than energy markets.

3. Invest in the Community Energy Fund

Join over 1,000 investor members who have between them invested almost £6 million to support our energy projects. Our Community Energy Fund accepts single investments from £250 to £100,000. In return we offer investors a target interest rate of 4%, rising to 5% after the first four years and regular updates on the environmental and social impact their investment is achieving.
